

Give the Gift of Health & Receive a Charitable Tax Credit!

El Rio Foundation is an approved Arizona Qualifying Charitable Organization (QCO). This individual income tax credit is available for contributions to QCO that provide immediate basic needs to residents of Arizona who receive temporary assistance for needy families (TANF) benefits, are low-income residents of Arizona, or are individuals who have a chronic illness or physical disability. The maximum QCO credit donation amount for 2023 is \$421 for a single, married filing separate or head of household; \$841 for married filing jointly. This tax credit is claimed on Arizona Form 321. El Rio Foundation QCO code is 20212.


